TECHNICAL CLUB



Philosophy of PO Mapping for Extracurricular Activities

The Program Outcome (PO) mapping for extracurricular activities is grounded in the philosophy of Outcome-Based Education (OBE), which emphasizes the holistic development of students through both academic and non-academic engagements. This approach recognizes that cultural and sports activities play a significant role in nurturing essential graduate attributes such as teamwork, leadership, communication, creativity, ethics, and resource management. Each extracurricular event is mapped to specific Expected Learning Outcomes (ELOs), which are further aligned with corresponding POs defined by the NBA framework. The impact of each activity is quantified based on student participation, and when events contribute to multiple POs, the participant count is equitably distributed among them. This ensures a fair representation of each PO's contribution. The total contributions are then normalized and mapped onto a three-level attainment scale—High (≥80%), Moderate (60-79%), and Low (<60%)—to evaluate the overall effectiveness of extracurricular programs in achieving targeted graduate outcomes. This evidence-based, student-centric methodology enables continuous quality enhancement by highlighting strengths and identifying areas requiring further development.
