"Covid - 19 Relief Project Phase 1"

St. Vincent Pallotti College of Engineering & Technology, Nagpur, undertook a Covid Relief Project in the villages of Dhuti (Dongargaon) and Rui adopted by them. The project will be implemented for a duration of 3 months by the SVPCET NSS Unit in collaboration with Pallotti Bread, a social initiative of Nagpur Pallottine Society.

In this Relief Project, 150 BPL families without ration card were identified. These families were then contacted and provided with Food Ration packets comprising of food grains, pulses, spices and cooking oil. The Gram Panchayats acted as centers for distribution of ration as per social distancing norms.

The first food ration packet distribution event was conducted on 19th June, 2020, in the presence of the Director, Fr. Dr. Paul Chandrankunnel, NSS Unit volunteers along with faculty and Fr. " NSS Unit Celebrates International Day of Yoga "



" Covid-19 Awareness Session "





The session was held on 20th September 2020 from 12:00-1:00p.m, for all students of the Department.






"India's COVID-19 fight is people driven."



"Online Workshop on Social Entrepreneurship, Swachhta & Rural Engagement (SESRE)"




Mrs. Karape interacted with students and elucidated in depth on Social Entrepreneurship and related National Level Competitions for SESREC participant institutes.

Vigilance Awareness Week & Integrity Pledge




In view of the above as per the directives of the AICTE, "Integrity Pledge" activity is to be carried out in an online mode for disseminating and publicizing the same among employees & students.




"Yoga Workshop"

Anti-Terrorism Day Observance


On 21st May, 2021, the NSS unit of our Institute, organized an Anti-Terrorism pledge-taking event to commemorate Anti-Terrorism Day.
